The Program is open to peak sport and active recreation providers and service providers who meet the eligibility requirements for funding.

Applicants should ensure that all information and supporting documentation provided is accurate before submitting.

Applications may not be assessed if they are incomplete.

Active Tasmania may conduct an audit process.
